A special THANKS to all those members who have been working extra week-ends helping to clean up tree limbs and debris at the Prairie House Museum from the ice storm in January.

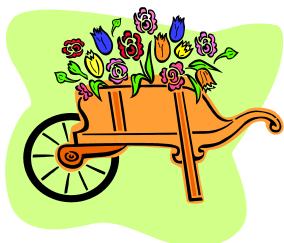

Warrior Bugs Ward Off Landscape Predators

What's hiding in your garden? It may be time to celebrate the beneficial insects, parasites and other organisms that keep away landscape-ruining pests. These good bugs also help you avoid the use of pesticides that can be harmful to plants and animals.

Warrior Bugs and What They do:

- Ladybugs feed on aphids, mealy bugs, scale insects and spider mites.
- Lacewings devour aphids, scales, mites, caterpillars and other pests.
- Ground beetles eat slug eggs
- Nematodes kill cutworms, armyworms, root weevil larvae, root maggots and crane fly larvae.

Other warrior bugs are yellow jackets, spiders, centipedes, rove beetles, and parasite wasps.
