Remembering fallen officers honors them and community values. On October 31, 2010, Seattle Police Officer Timothy Brenton was ambushed and killed and his trainee, Officer Britt Sweeny was wounded. Then, on Sunday, Nov. 29th came the terrible murders of Lakewood Police Sergeant Mark Renninger and Officers Greg Richards, Tina Griswold and Ronald Owens in Parkland. It was the single adversarial loss of law enforcement life in the history of Pierce County and Washington State. We lost six good people. Their families lost far more.
