A YARD MAP TO SPRING PLANTING SUCCESS

Know Your Site: Draw your existing landscape on paper and highlight planting beds, note their locations and soil type (sandy, loam or clay), as well as plants, buildings, slopes and drainage.

Develop a Plan: Select areas that best suit your needs; create a landscape plan by outlining specific use areas.

Select the Right Plants: Once you have a plan, begin choosing plants best suited for your site. Native plants or those adapted to our climate require less water. Disease-resistant plants will help prevent spread of pests, too.
