**EARTH MATTERS**

**Questions & Answers with Recycling Coordinator Sheryl Rhinehart**

**Let's start with garbage. How much garbage do we throw away each day?**

**Answer: The average resident throws away 3.2 pounds of waste. This is good news. It's down from 4.5 pounds in 2007. Pierce County's goal is one pound of waste per person per day by 2032. How can we make that happen?**

**Answer: Recycling the right things is a start. We learned that nearly 1/3 of survey respondents still put paper, aluminum cans, and plastic bottles and tubs in the garbage.**

**Aren't all these items accepted in recycling bins?**

**Answer: Yes. They are accepted in bins and at drop-off sites around Pierce County.**
